POLICE COMPLAINT COMMISSIONER ORDERS A PUBLIC HEARING

Victoria - The Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner today announced a Public Hearing into allegations of police misconduct with respect to Constable Stephen Todd of the Vancouver Police Department.

On March 8, 2011, the Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner received information from the Vancouver Police Department in which allegations of professional misconduct against Constable Stephen Todd were raised. The allegations included deceit, neglect of duty, corrupt practice, improper disclosure of information and discreditable conduct.

The allegations were investigated and the matter was adjudicated through the police disciplinary process. The external Discipline Authority determined misconduct had been proven in relation to some of the allegations and proposed dismissal as one of the disciplinary measures. Pursuant to the *Police Act*, a member may request a public hearing or review on the record where the disciplinary measure proposed is dismissal or a reduction in rank. Through his legal counsel, Constable Todd has requested a public hearing.

The Police Complaint Commissioner has determined that a public hearing is necessary in the public interest in relation to all of the allegations of professional misconduct alleged against Constable Todd.

Upon the recommendation of the Associate Chief Justice of the British Columbia Supreme Court, retired BC Court of Appeal Justice Wally Oppal, Q.C., is appointed to preside as Adjudicator in these proceedings, pursuant to section 142(2) of the *Police Act*.

A date for the Public Hearing will be determined in the future.
