**Review on the Record into the Admissible Complaint against  
Special Municipal Constable Rajdeep Mann of the Vancouver Police Department**

**Victoria** - The Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner wishes to advise the media that a Review on the Record will be held into the disciplinary decision involving Special Municipal Constable Rajdeep Mann of the Vancouver Police Department and will commence in the near future.

The Police Complaint Commissioner has determined that the Discipline Authority's findings after a discipline proceeding into allegations of *Abuse of Authority, Discourtesy, Discreditable Conduct* and *Deceit* were incorrect and is, therefore, remitting the matter for adjudicative review.

A date has yet to be determined.

**Key Facts:**

- The Police Complaint Commissioner is a civilian, independent Officer of the Legislature overseeing complaints, investigations and discipline involving municipal police in British Columbia.
- A Review on the Record is a form of adjudicative review in which the adjudicator, a Retired Judge, conducts a "paper review" of all evidence and materials from the investigation and discipline hearing. The adjudicator may also receive submissions from the respondent's counsel, the Police Complaint Commissioner's counsel, the complainant and the Discipline Authority before rendering his/her decision.

- The adjudicator must determine whether there is misconduct and, if so, determine the corrective or disciplinary measures to be imposed. The adjudicator's decision at a review on the record is final and conclusive.
- The adjudicator can also make recommendations to the Chief Constable or Police Board concerning any changes in policy or practice that the adjudicator considers advisable.
