The Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner (OPCC) completed its review of the decision issued by the Discipline Authority pursuant to section 133 of the *Police Act* in this matter. Based on a review of the discipline proceeding, we have determined that there is not a reasonable basis to believe the decision of the Discipline Authority is incorrect and that a Public Hearing or Review on the Record is not necessary in the public interest.
