

## CONCLUSION OF PROCEEDINGS

The Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner (OPCC) has completed its review of the decision issued by the Discipline Authority pursuant to section 133 of the *Police Act* in this matter.

Mr. [REDACTED] and Sergeant [REDACTED] were provided a copy of Mr. David Pendleton's findings in relation to each allegation of misconduct and determinations on appropriate disciplinary or corrective measures at the Discipline Proceeding. Mr. [REDACTED] and Constable [REDACTED] were informed that if they were aggrieved by either the findings or determinations, they could file a written request with the Police Complaint Commissioner to arrange a public hearing or review on the record.

To date, the OPCC has not received a request from Mr. [REDACTED]

Based on a review of the discipline proceeding, we have determined that there is not a reasonable basis to believe the decision of the Discipline Authority is incorrect and that a Public Hearing or Review on the Record is not necessary in the public interest.

Therefore, there are insufficient grounds to arrange a public hearing or review on the record in the circumstances. This assessment has been reviewed by the Police Complaint Commissioner who agrees with the determination in this matter.

The decision to conclude this matter is final and this office will take no further action.
