REVISED SECTION 150 ORDER
THIS ORDER REPLACES AND RESCINDS ALL PRIOR ORDERS MADE IN THE
PROCEEDINGS

1. No person shall publish or broadcast any information or records that could identify the individual described in the Notice of Review on the Record as the “Affected Person,” including without limitation: 1) her name, place of residence, or contact information (phone, email, or social media); 2) her current or former places of employment; 3) her image; 4) any audio recordings of her voice; and 5) the names, place of residence, contact information, and relationship to the Affected Person of other civilian witnesses interviewed as part of the investigation that underlies these proceedings, as well as their images and any audio recordings of their voices.
2. The information and records described in the previous paragraph shall be withheld from any written or oral submissions or other public communications regarding the Review on the Record, including published decisions or rulings.
3. Any materials to be posted on the Review on the Records page of the OPCC website regarding the Review on the Record shall be in a form approved by the Adjudicator, after giving Counsel in the matter and the Affected Person an opportunity to make submissions about whether the proposed content is suitable for posting having regard for the terms of this Order.
4. Access to the record of disciplinary decision in this matter (as defined in section 141(3) of the *Police Act*) by persons other than authorized participants in the proceedings shall be by application to the Registrar and shall be determined by the Adjudicator after giving Counsel in the matter and the Affected Person an

opportunity to make submissions about whether some or all of the requested material should be excluded having regard for the terms of this Order.

5. All disclosure or materials received by authorized participants in the proceeding will remain confidential and subject to the terms of this Order.
6. This Order shall be posted on the OPCC website and at any in-person public appearances that may be held with respect to the Review on the Record. The terms of this Order may be modified, clarified, amplified, or rescinded by the Adjudicator, on application or otherwise, and this Order shall not detract from the authority of the Adjudicator to make further orders under Section 150. Absent its being rescinded in any such further order, this Order shall remain in effect.
