Victoria – Media are invited to a technical briefing with OPCC general counsel Brian Smith in advance of the start of a public hearing into the actions of seven Vancouver police (VPD) officers on August 13, 2015, and the subsequent death of 33-year-old Myles Gray.

This public hearing will be one of the largest in terms of the number of officers and legal counsel involved, the volume of documentary evidence disclosed, and its projected length of ten weeks.

When: Thursday January 15, 2026, at 11am (PST).

Where: Online - Microsoft TEAMS

How: Media participants must register by Wednesday, January 14 at 5pm (PST). Only [registered media participants](#) will be admitted to the briefing.

Special Notes: General background materials on the public hearing process will be provided to approved registrants on the morning of January 15.

The briefing will outline technical aspects of the public hearing process, names and roles of the participants and how to access materials approved for public release by the Adjudicator.

While the public hearing is underway, the OPCC will not provide comments about the merits of the case other than through its counsel at the public hearing.
