Victoria – The public hearing into allegations of police misconduct relating to the death of Myles Gray will resume at 9:30 a.m. PST on Tuesday, February 24, 2026.

The public hearing is currently expected to continue over the next three weeks from February 24 to February 27, March 2 to March 6, and March 9 to 13, 2026. It's expected that more dates will be scheduled as the case progresses.

The public hearing will be held in Room C440 at UBC Robson Square, located at 800 Robson Street in downtown Vancouver. Each day is expected to start at 9:30 a.m. There will be limited seating in the hearing room and seats will generally be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

The hearing will be [audio streamed online](#), and a link will be available on the [OPCC website](#). The Adjudicator has made an [Order on Access and Recording](#) in this case that, among other things, prohibits the audio or video recording of the proceeding, subject to certain limited exceptions for the media who make audio recordings for the sole purpose of verifying their notes.

While the public hearing is underway, the OPCC will not provide comments about the merits of the case other than through its counsel at the public hearing.
