The Office of the Police Complaint Commissioner (OPCC) completed its review of the decision issued by the Discipline Authority pursuant to section 133 of the *Police Act* in this matter.

1. *Abuse of Authority*, pursuant to section 77(3)(a)(ii)(A) of the *Police Act*; specifically, the deployment of a police dog that caused injuries to the affected person on November 24, 2022.

### Discipline Proposed - Written Reprimand

Based on a review of the discipline proceeding, we have determined that there is not a reasonable basis to believe the decision of the Discipline Authority is incorrect and that a Public Hearing or Review on the Record is not necessary in the public interest.

Therefore, there are insufficient grounds to arrange a public hearing or review on the record in the circumstances. The decision to conclude this matter is final and this office will take no further action.

In relation to the substantiated allegation, the disciplinary or corrective measure imposed are approved. Our file with respect to this matter will be concluded upon receipt of confirmation that in accordance with *Police Act*, any disciplinary or corrective measure imposed in relation to, or agreed to by, a member or former member, has been completed, and that their service record of discipline has been updated.
